Add Top Header and Reinforced Patches:

With this option you are choosing to have the normal heading that is on the left side (hoist end) removed and having a header put on horizontally that runs the length of the top of the flag. There are sewn in patches in the bottom left and right corner that help to reinforce the flag when it is hanging. This header will consist of a white piece of canvas sewn over the top to create a hemmed border with grommets spaced evenly throughout. The number and spacing of grommets will vary depending on the size of the flag. The purpose of doing this is so it can easily be hung horizontally from the wall, ceiling etc. This is not meant to flown on a flagpole.



Add Fly End Corners Only:

With this option you are choosing to keep the current heading and thimbles that come on the left side (hoist end) and add a roped canvas heading and thimbles to the right (fly end) side of the flag. The roped heading is a piece of rope that runs the length of the short side of the flag and wraps around two metal loops (thimbles) that are on the corners of the flag. A piece of white canvas with a grommet midway between the two thimbles is then sewn over the rope and flag to create a hemmed border. When this is complete you will have thimbles in all four corners of the flag. The purpose of doing this is to have something to hang the flag from when hanging on a wall, building or even ceiling. Once these modifications have been done to your flag, flying your flag on a flagpole will cause serious damage to your flag due to the added weight on the fly end.

Add Top Header and Grommets Only:

With this option you are choosing to have the normal heading that is on the left side (hoist end) removed and having a header put on horizontally that runs the length of the top of the flag. This header will consist of a white piece of canvas sewn over the top to create a hemmed border with grommets spaced evenly throughout. The number and spacing of grommets will vary depending on the size of the flag. The purpose of doing this is so it can easily be hung horizontally from the wall, ceiling etc. This is not meant to flown on a flagpole.
